

Georg Henrik von Wright on Wittgenstein's Last Writings (On Certainty)

Georg Henrik von Wright's paper 'Wittgenstein on Certainty' was one of the very first comments published on Wittgenstein's posthumous work *On Certainty*. The present paper is an attempt at seeing von Wright's contribution in its historical context and to discuss the question whether, or to what extent, his discussions of central Wittgensteinian notions like 'world-picture', 'form of life' and what von Wright called 'pre-knowledge' can help us to get a fruitful perspective on Wittgenstein's last writings.
